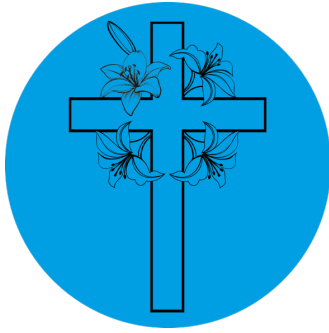
# Initial PTFA Scoping Meeting
